Overview

This style guide is intended to inform how MHCF, as an organization, communicates about its work in American Indian Health and the people and communities it collaborates with.

It reflects the most current thinking on terminology for Native people and communities.

General Guidelines

- 1.Be as specific as possible when referring to Native people and Native nations.
- 2. Referring to the tribes in MT as "Native nations" shows respect for their sovereignty & independent status.
- 3.Do not use the state's possessive when referring to Native nations.
- 4. Terminology is subject to personal preference. Take the time to learn what individual and community preferences are.

Native Nations

In MT, there are 13 federally recognized tribes on 7 reservations.

The United States recognizes these tribes as nations.

Urban Indians

We use the term "urban Indian" when referring to the health centers in MT's 5 urban areas and the Native American people they serve.

Land Acknowledgments

While we recognize land acknowledgements signify good intentions, we recommend not using them in our meetings and events.
